Mission Statement

Adat Reyim Preschool seeks to provide children with a safe and nurturing environment. Adat Reyim Preschool will place emphasis on Jewish experiences and values while helping to provide a gateway to the Jewish community and the Congregation Adat Reyim. The preschool will focus on meeting the early childhood needs of children, as well as their families. The children will be encouraged to explore and develop the necessary social skills, problem solving and decision making skills as well as physical awareness, fine and gross motor skills.

TWO YEAR OLD PROGRAM (21-36 MONTHS AS OF SEPT. 30)

Parents may chose from the following options:

2 Day Option: Monday/Wednesday

2 Day Option: Tuesday/Thursday

3 Day Option: Any variation of the days offered

4 Day Option: Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

The goals of the two year old program are to help your children learn to separate from their parents, build their ability to work and play alongside and with other individuals, and learn Jewish holidays and customs. The curriculum also includes beginning language skills, communication, art and physical movement.

THREE YEAR OLD PROGRAM (3 YEARS OLD AS OF SEPT. 30)

3 Day Program: Monday/Wednesday/Friday

The goals of the three year old program are to promote learning though a variety of different activities including arts and crafts, music, physical movement, learning Jewish customs and celebrating holidays. Children continue to build on concepts such as working and playing alongside and with their peers, learning to follow instructions and developing their listening skills. The curriculum also continues to develop and strengthen language and communication skills.

**FOUR YEAR OLD PROGRAM
(4 YEARS OLD AS OF SEPT.30)**

4 Day Program: Tuesday-Friday

The goal of the 4 year old program is to promote readiness for Kindergarten. Children learn the skills needed to be successful for Kindergarten such as developing the social skills necessary to be able to work and play in a group and participating in teacher directed activities. These skills are reinforced through activities including games, music, arts and crafts, and physical movement, all while encompassing the Jewish holidays and customs. . The curriculum continues to develop and strengthen language, writing and communication skills.

**PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM
(4 YEARS OLD AS OF NOV. 30)**

5 Day Program: Monday-Friday

The Pre-Kindergarten program is an opportunity for older 4 year olds and young 5 year olds who may not be ready for Kindergarten but need more than Preschool. The Pre-Kindergarten class is a small class with more structure than the 4 year old program but less structure than Kindergarten. The goal of this program is to promote social readiness for Kindergarten while continuing to reinforce academic skills including language, writing, and communication skills, as well as beginning mathematics, etc.

LUNCH BUNCH

Lunch Bunch is a one hour addition to the 2 and 3 Year Old Preschool day, and is available to children Monday-Friday. The children learn to sit together and socialize while eating lunch and then continue the hour with low-key play time and stories.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Adat Reyim Preschool offers a wide range of Enrichment Classes taught after Preschool hours. Often times these classes are taught by parent volunteers and vary each year. The Adat Reyim Enrichment Programs have included art, music, poetry, nutrition and physical activity and are offered from 1:30 pm-2:15 pm.

ABOUT OUR DIRECTOR

Preschool and Camp Director: Gail Froehlich: Miss Gail assumed the position of Director in 1996 after being the 4 Year Old Lead Teacher at the Jewish Community Center of Northern Virginia Preschool for six years and the Director of the Mini Gan Israel Camp for eight years. Gail has a degree in Psychology and Sociology and was a Social Worker for many years before having her own children. Gail has been an active member of the Adat Reyim Congregation since 1990. In Gail's Adat Reyim past she has held the position of Kindergarten and First Grade Sunday School Teacher, as well as the Synagogue Membership Coordinator.
